GROUP PERSONAL ACCIDENT POLICY: PAYMENT OF BENEFITS TO DECEASED

1. Please ref AWES Circular No 001/Gen/2010 dt 08 Sep 10.
2. Over the last yr or so following have been noticed while implementing the above AWES SOP:-
 - (a) Late submission of Reports (para 11 of SOP) and thereafter claims by schools/colleges resulting in repudiation of many cases.
 - (b) Incomplete docu/data being submitted while preferring claims.
 - (c) Non submission of certain docu required (in original).
 - (d) Inaccurate info being submitted resulting in delay in passing claims.
 - (e) Translations of FIR/other reports in Hindi/English not being submitted.
3. While it is imp to follow the laid down procedures it is equally imp to ensure its accuracy as well as timely submission. In this regard it will not be out of place to mention that obtaining data/docu, by sending a person from school, will help a lot rather than letting the case be repudiated or get into avoidable corres.
4. Another very imp experience has been Principals/Management not guiding parents and or right authorities to maint adequate checks/balances to avoid preventable road accidents. This is more in case of death due two wheeler accidents. 80% of the claims being submitted are due to this reason. Since they are mostly preventable, they need continuous and immediate attn.
5. A No of accidents are happening because our students are driving scooter/motor cycle w/o licience and helmet. Also the two wheeler is to be on his/her name for the claim to be accepted. In a recent Supreme Court Order it has been ruled that parents of such children will be liable to punishment first. Various law enforcing agencies have been auth to book such people in future in the country. Thus driving by unlicensed students needs to be stopped forthwith in all our schools/colleges. Use of helmet by drivers needs to be also ensured at the time of deciding who all are permitted/essential students to drive while coming to school/college.

6. Besides being a social obligation, management of all schools/colleges are requested to implement the above guidelines in their respective areas of responsibility more diligently and also carryout checks with the help of army authorities in a suitable manner.
7. Vide para 5 Circular premium for the pd 01 Aug 11-31 Jul 12 is to be paid by 30 May 11. This should be noted also for timely completion. All fmn HQ (AWES Cells) need to monitor such timely implementation of orders.
8. Fmn HQ, AWES Cells are requested to further monitor/fine tune the above as deemed necessary.
